5. **Sushil Cherian.** Lead the effort to identify known failure modes
6. **Himanshu Khurana.** Lead the effort to determine the next generation PMU features
7. **David Chassin.** Will brainstorm ideas on the roles of the PDC inside NASPInet to share with the team.

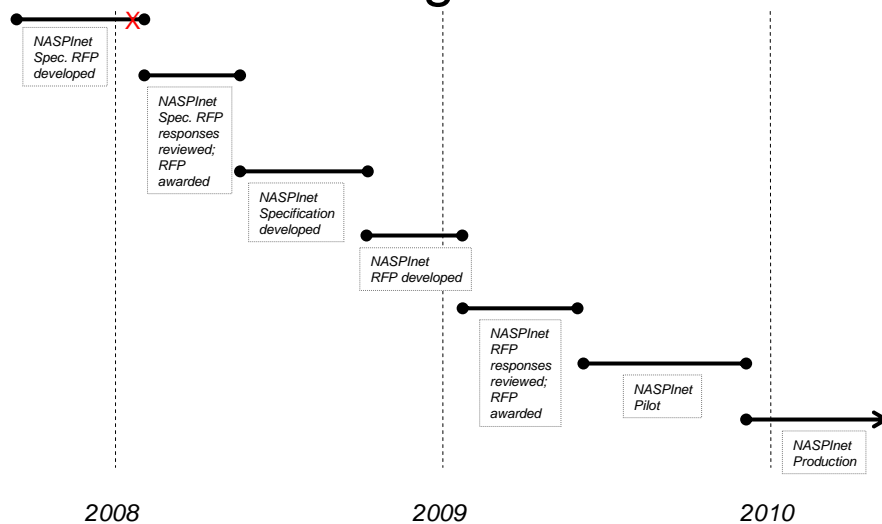
## MINUTES

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Notes from the meeting are as follows.

1. Paul received a request for “Data Hub” configuration information. This was discussed.
2. RFP progress review along with overall NASPInet timeline was discussed. Kris talked about the RFP schedule. The RFP specification is still at NETL. There is an RFP team that will be reviewing the RFPs. The schedule shows that the RFP team will be reviewing the RFPs sometime this summer. The basic sequence of major milestones is below.

3. DNMTT Meeting schedule proposed by Paul was to meet at least 2 times a month to prep for the June meeting. We will set meeting up.
4. Paul discussed key deliverables and assigned leads for each. These are:
  - a. Interface with specification vendor to help guide the effort
  - b. System conventions (Utilities)
  - c. Identify known failure modes which include anything that causes loss of data on where it needs to be and classify it.
  - d. Next generation PMU features which includes inputs to standard process, features that are useful to data management, and coordination with the PSTT.
  - e. Roles of the PDC inside NASPInet
  - f. Raise awareness of the transition to NASPInet

The meeting was then adjourned.
