Meeting Recap

- Reviewed team mission statement for new members.
- Discussed status of remaining focus area documents.
- Reviewed results of the IEEE Enhanced State Estimation Survey that paralleled the CRSTT survey from 2016.
 - NASPI survey resulted in too many “I don’t know” responses to draw conclusions.
 - IEEE survey generated enough significant responses to begin work on a Linear State Estimation paper.
- Performed brief review of the *Using Synchrophasor Data For Oscillation Detection* document (ETC: 12/2017)
 - 13 Utility Responses / 6 Vendor Responses
 - Distributed to CRSTT email distribution list just prior to meeting. Will redistribute for comments after meeting.

Meeting Recap (Cont.)

- Discussed need to make progress on focus area docs and use case papers. May explore video options.
- Requested team members to help gather info necessary to create more video event files.
- Held lengthy discussion about CIP V5 impacts. Many feel that uncertainty in CIP requirements, real or perceived, is hampering efforts to move the technology into the control room. Discussed need to allow some level of accommodation for R&D to solicit feedback and develop operational tools.
- Marianna provided a quick overview of the LSE Demonstration under the PRSP Project.
