## **Meeting Notes**

- Thank you to those of you who attended our call today!
- DNMTT reviewed the most current Work Plan. This document was mirrored from the CRSTT
  Work Plan. Matt proposed an update to the mission statement that better aligns to the goals of
  the DNMTT; providing guidance for synchrophasor data networking, archiving and access issues
  and reviewing new archiving and networking technologies for the best fit to synchrophasor
  application realization.
  - Project definition categories revised to existing network and archive issue guidance and reviewing new archiving and network strategies to support development application requirements.
  - o Planned activities revised to interact with other NASPI task team to provide network and archive management guidance for applications realized for industry consumption.
  - Project A1 will be a NASPI report including survey results of utility archives and vendor existing and proposed archives. (referenced DNMTT - NASPI 2014 Survey of Synchrophasor System Networks — Results and Findings). DNMTT will be working on a new report to document the 2019 survey results. Volunteers needed to help with this task! Please apply within.
  - Project A2, Executive summary of NASPInet 2.0 for distribution to industry vendors, was removed.
  - New Project A3 is a review or new industry archiving and network concepts for best fits for application development
  - o Dan likes the work plan and suggests that we accept the changes and send out the clean document to DNMTT for comment.
- DNMTT would like to put together the first part of A1 document, similar to the network survey. John Volpert offered to help build the first part of the paper.



- DNMTT call for papers will be coming out soon. NASPI LT would like to solicit papers after the spring NASPI Work Group meeting to avoid confusion. Papers will be due December 31, 2020 and a full report will be provided at the NASPI fall Work Group meeting 2021.
- The DNMTT will probably find value in meeting with the other task teams to keep our goals and objectives aligned and to help find solutions to the pressing issues.
